## **Things You Should Know**

- CAUTION: There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored in bear boxes.
- Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.
- ◆ Union Valley Bike Trail is a 5 mile long paved accessible bike trail from Jones Fork Campground to Tells Creek along the east side of the Reservoir.
