Eldorado National Forest Pacific Ranger District

Location

23 miles east of Placerville on Highway 50 and 31 miles north on Ice House Road (Forest Road 3) on the north side of Loon Lake.

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Swimming, Fishing, Hiking, Boat Ramp/Loading Dock
- ⇒ Boat Ramp at Loon Lake Campground
- ⇒ Hiking and horseback riding in Desolation Wilderness
 - ◆ Permits required for both day use and overnight use. Overnight permits are available www.recreation.gov or the Placerville Ranger Station on Highway 50, Exit 54 in Camino). Day use permits area available at the Loon Lake trailhead in the summer and Placerville Ranger Station year-round.
- ⇒ The campground is located near the Rubicon Jeep Trail, which is a popular 4-WD run.) Visitors will need to obtain and follow the Eldorado National Forest Motorized Vehicle Use Map.

Things You Should Know

- ◆ **CAUTION:** There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ Tents only – No trailers or motor homes.
- ◆ **Keep the gate closed or visitors will wander in. Gate combination is issued when reservations are finalized.**
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.



- ◆ RV filling from piped water sources in campgrounds and day use areas is NOT permitted.

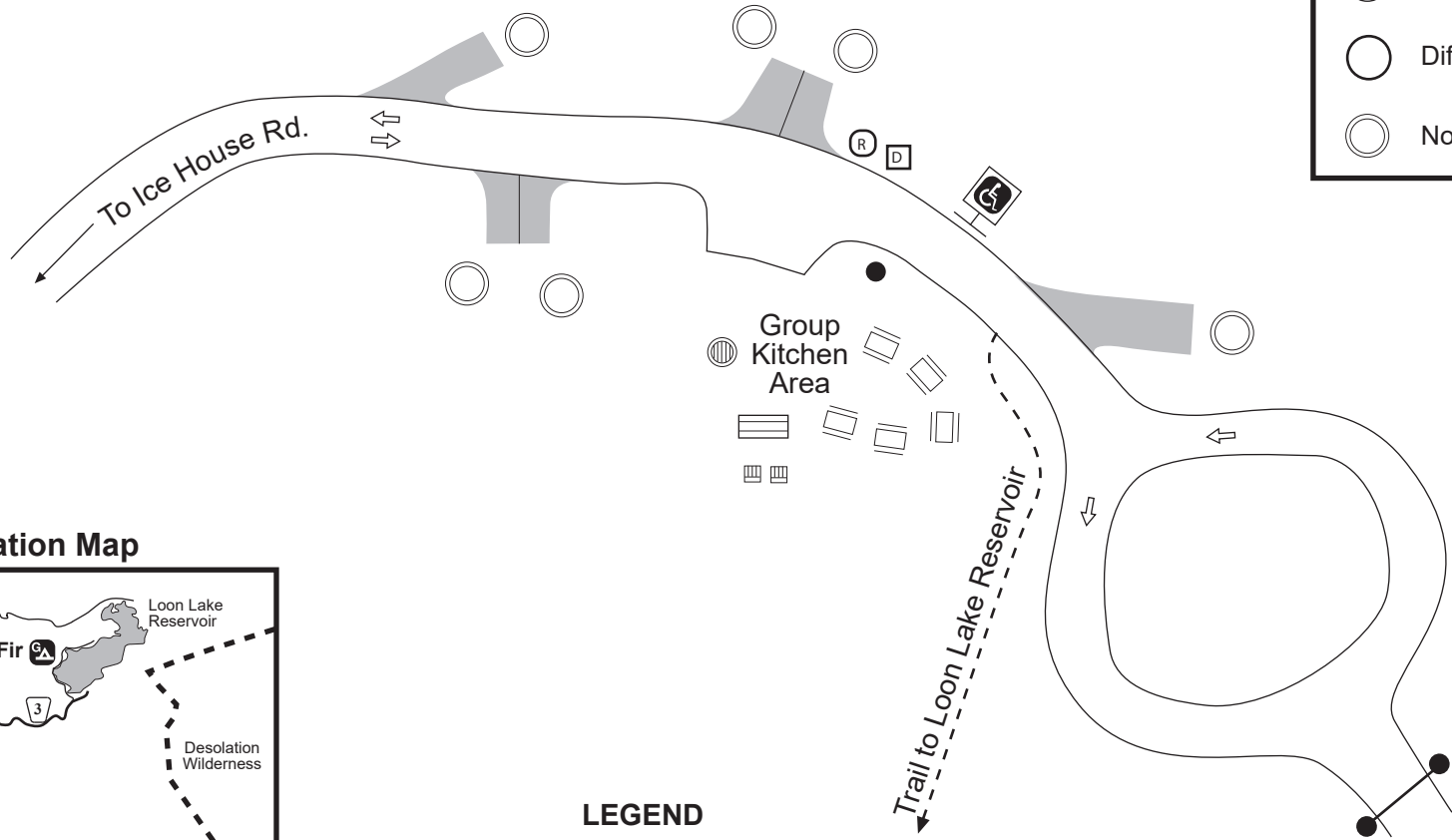

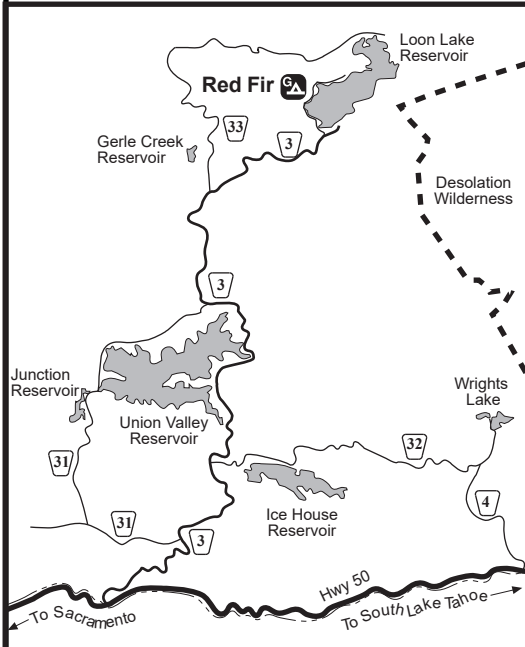
