

## WHAT IS THE SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS (SRS) PROGRAM?

SRS provides necessary funding to over 700 U.S. and Puerto Rico counties for roads, schools, and other municipal services.

- The Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act was passed in 2000 to stabilize funds available to rural counties.
- Payments are divided into 3 categories:
  - I. **Title I**: Roads and Schools
- II. Title II: Projects on Federal Lands
- III. Title III: County Projects

- RAC members review and recommend Title II projects for the Forest Supervisor and comment on Title III projects.
- Every RAC has balanced representation in 3 main interest areas: commercial, environment, and local.
- RACs are made up of 15 members.
- Members are required to reside in the state of Mississippi
- You don't have to be an expert to apply. All that is required is a strong interest in community or environmental well-being.
