FOREST ORDER NO. 06-03-01-24-04

TRUMAN TRAIL NETWORK: 1E, 207, 207A, 216D, 216E AND FOREST SYSTEM ROAD 99 EXTENSION ENTRY RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on Truman Trail Networks within Mount St. Helens National Volcanic Monument of the Gifford Pinchot National Forest. FSR 9900 Extension Closure Area is as described below and on the area Maps_(Exhibits A & B). This Order is effective from May 15, 2024, through December 30, 2027, unless rescinded earlier.

PROHIBITIONS:

- 1. Entering into or being in the Restricted Area Monday through Friday during the Order effective dates. This area is closed due to construction activities. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e). The Restricted Area is as follows:
 - The southern portion of the Windy Ridge Parking area for contractor staging;
 - FR 99 extension road from Windy Ridge to the Truman Trail;
 - TR 207 Truman Trail from TR 216E Windy to TR 1 Boundary;
 - TR 216D Plains of Abraham from TR216 Loowit to FR 99 extension Road;
 - TR 216E Windy from TR 207 Truman to TR 216 Loowit;
 - TR 207A Truman from TR 216 Loowit to TR 207 Truman;
 - TR 1E Harry's Ridge.
- 2. Landing of aircraft, or dropping or picking up any material, supplies, or person by means of an aircraft, including a helicopter. 36 C.F.R. 261.58(y).

Note: The term *aircraft* encompasses Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS or "drones"). Aircraft is defined as any device invented, used, or designed for flying in the air. 49 U.S.C. § 40102; 14 C.F.R. § 1.1.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:


- 1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3551, 3559, 3571, and 3581).
