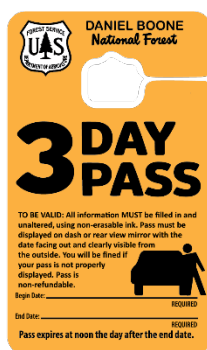
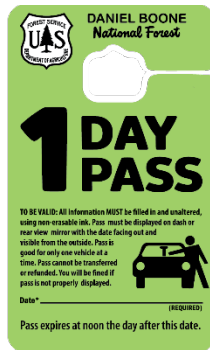
Where forest passes are required the fee is charged for use of facilities at:

- Boat ramps
- Shooting ranges
- Backcountry camping in the Red River Gorge
- OHV use of OHV trails
- Natural Arch Scenic Area facilities

Rental fees are charged at some sites to cover the administrative costs of managing rentals. These passes are available at local vendors or any Forest Service office. Check the forest website at www.fs.usda.gov/dbnf for a listing of local vendors.

Forest Service offices accept cash, check and credit card payment. Credit cards are accepted at some vendors.

- Annual passes expire December 31 of the year purchased; 1-day and 3-day passes expire at noon on the day after the last day of the pass. No refunds.
- Any motorized vehicle or motorcycle that occupies a space in a fee area listed here and/or signed as a fee area is required to display a pass.
- Interagency pass discounts are only offered when permits are purchased at a Forest Service office. Vendors do not offer the discount.
- Only one annual pass may be purchased with the pass discount.

Discounts are available on the Daniel Boone Annual Pass, 1 & 3 Day Passes and Annual Sticker with the following passes: Lifetime Senior, Senior Annual, Access and Golden Age.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations at some sites are available by calling the National Recreation Reservation System Contact Center at 877-444-6777 or at <https://www.recreation.gov>.

- Online reservation fees are \$8, non-refundable.
- Contact Center reservations (877-444-6777) fees are \$9, non-refundable.
- Reservations can be made only for the summer recreation season.
- Reservation can be made up to 6 months in advance for individual campsites and 12 months in advance for group campsites and cabins.
- Some sites may require two or three nights of minimum stay on weekends and holidays.

Opening and closing dates are subject to change. Call for exact dates. Single site capacity: 6 people, 2 vehicles. Double site capacity: 12 people, 4 vehicles.

PAY AT SITE FEES

Payment envelopes are provided at sites that require fees to be deposited at the recreation site. Accepted payments are cash or check. Change is not available. State and local taxes apply to some fee areas.

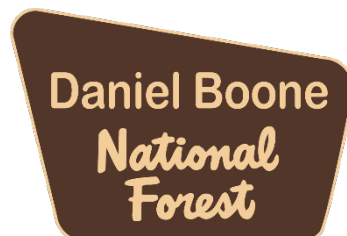
