Additional Statement of Work

VHF radio kits (NFES 004381) need to be programmed with VTAC channels before shipping.

USFS will utilize other Federal agency and State/local resources under existing agreement, as appropriate.

USFS will preposition resources and/or provide assistance to FEMA. USFS is responsible for providing personnel and/or equipment necessary to accomplish the mission.

This MA is funded with American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 funding and must be operationally complete by 09/30/2025. Any expenditures under this MA must be submitted to FEMA no later than 09/30/2030.

ADDITIONAL NOTES from FEMA:
