

ORDER

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS

Wallowa-Whitman NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order within the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest, until further notice.

(1.) Operating a vehicle in violation of the speed, load, weight, height, length, width, or other limitations specified by the order. For the purpose of this order, this restriction applies to vehicles operated on the National Forest System Roads or segments listed in Appendix A of this order at speeds greater than the speed limitations specified for those roads and segments in Appendix A of this order.


Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

(1.) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.

(2.) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty, when operating an emergency vehicle in accordance with applicable state law.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)

7300, from its junction with County Road 1146 at the Forest Boundary to its junction with Ski Area parking area at Forest Road 7300170	35 Miles Per Hour
7300, also known as 7300002 which is .2 miles in length, From its junction with 7300170 near the start of Ski Area parking area to end of Ski Area parking area.	15 Miles Per Hour
