

ORDER NUMBER 384

Use of Forest Development Roads
Wallowa-Whitman National Forest

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50 (b) , until further notice, the following act is prohibited within the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest on the following roads listed below.

- (1) Using any vehicles with wheels or tracts equipped with metal lugs.
36 CFR 261.52 (a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited Act.

Description of roads affected by the Order:

- (1) Forest Service Road No. 73 from Baker County Road 1146 to Granite.
- (2) Forest Service Road No. 51 from State Hwy 244 to Forest Service road No. 52.
- (3) Forest Service Road No. 52 from Forest Service Road No. 73 to Forest boundary.
- (4) Forest Service Road No. 39 from State Hwy. 86 to Wallowa County Road 4602.
- (5) Forest Service Road No. 46 from State Hwy. 3 to Forest Service Road No. 4610.
- (6) Forest Service Road No. 4625 from Forest Service Road No. 46 to end of the pavement.
- (7) Forest Service Road No. 16 from State Hwy. 26 to Malheur/Wallowa-Whitman Forest boundary.
- (8) Forest Service Road No. 1843 from State Hwy. 30 to its end.
- (9) Forest Service Road No. 3965 from Forest Service Road No. 39 to Hells Canyon Overlook.
- (10) Forest Service Road 3960 from Forest Service Road No. 39 to Indian Crossing trailhead.
- (11) Forest Service Road 8205 from Wallowa County Road 521 to its end.

Violations of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. Title 16 USC Section 551.

Order Justification and Law Enforcement Plan

Vehicles equipped with metal lugs can cause a lot of damage to paved roads in a short period of time. This order will prohibit the use of metal lugs on the main paved roads on the Forest, and will help prevent major damage.

Signs will be posted on roads listed in this order notifying the user that vehicles with lugs are prohibited.

Enforcement of this order will be through Timber Sale Contracts in the area, monitoring mining activity, and District employees performing their routine regular activities. If a violation is observed, the vehicle description will be reported to an authorized Level II law Enforcement Officer who will issue a Notice of Violation.
