

ORDER NUMBER 383

ROAD CLOSURE
Wallowa-Whitman National Forest
La Grande Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50 (a) and (b), until further notice, the following acts are prohibited within areas and upon portions of forest development roads listed below within the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest.

1. Using any motorized vehicle on Forest development roads or segments listed, (36 CFR 261.54(a))

The following people are exempt from this order (36 CFR 261.50(e)):

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Description of closure: Forest Development Road 5110 between the gate at intersection with Forest development road 51 and the gate at milepost 1.93 on 5110.

Closure beginning in T.4S. R.35E. Section 11 and ends in T.4S. R.35E. Section 13. Willamette Meridian.

Closure is in effect annually, February 1 through May 31.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. Title 16 USC Section 551.

JUSTIFICATION

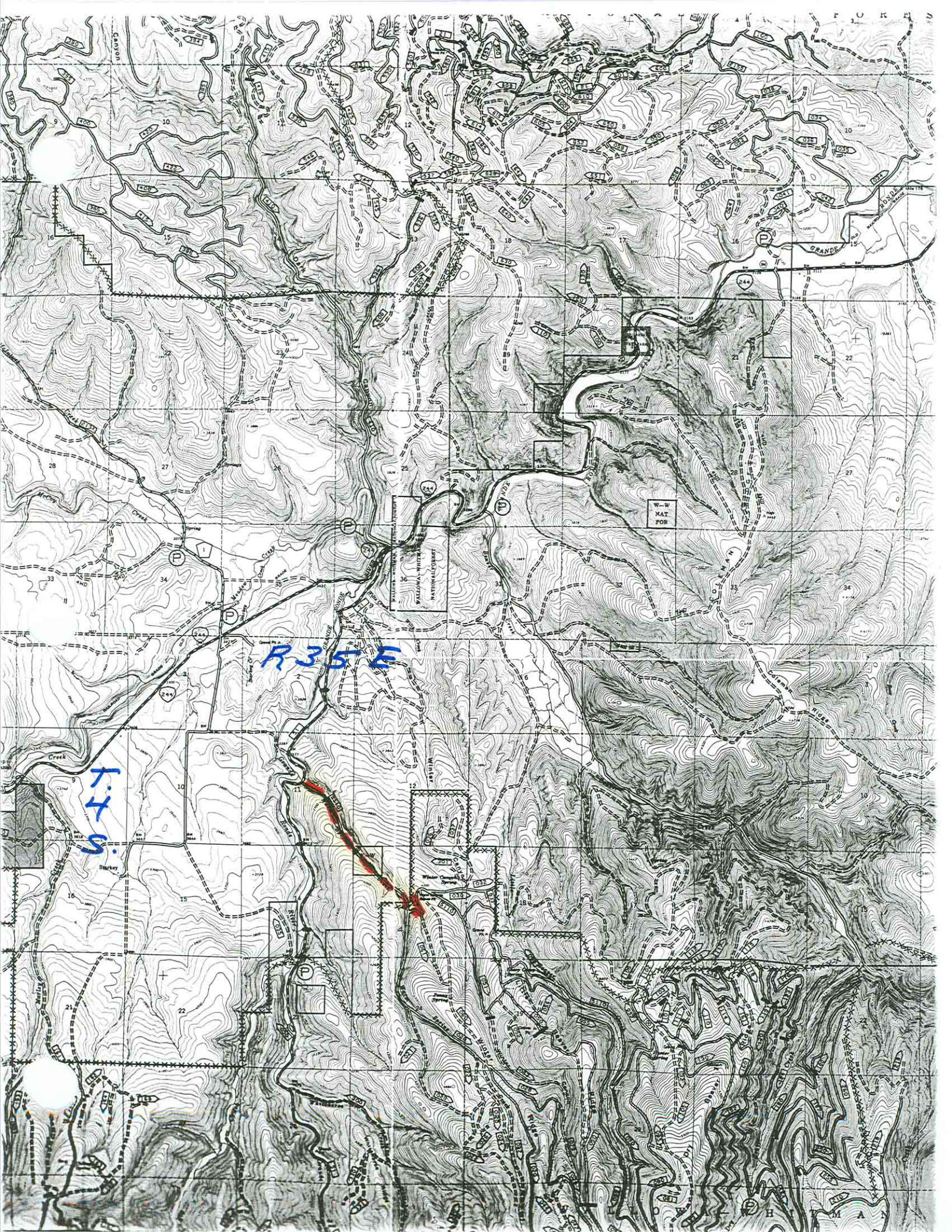
Road 5110 is adjacent to Warm Spring Creek which is a tributary to the Grande Ronde River. This road contributes sediment to the creek during heavy runoff associated with spring break up. The amount of sediment is increased when vehicles use the road while water is running on the road surface and road damage is also increased due to the softness of the road structure in early spring. The closure period will be short and generally occur during March and April.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

Law enforcement will be by La Grande District Forest Protection Officers (FPO). Other district personnel will report violations to FPO'S or Zone Law Enforcement Officers.

POSTING PLAN

Gates will be signed ROAD CLOSED. District road manager will be responsible for managing the closure.
