ORDER NUMBER 379

OCCUPANCY AND USE

Wallowa-Whitman National Forest La Grande Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order on the La Grande Ranger District, within the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest, until further notice.

1. Discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun within 1/4 mile of Indian Rock Overlook. (36 CFR 261.58 (m)).

Description of Area:

1. Indian Rock Overlook Developed Recreation Site, in Township 1 South, Range 38 East, Section 19, Willamette Meridian.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force, in the performance of an official duty.

Violations of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. Title 16 USC Section 551.

JUSTIFICATION


Indian Rock is a popular developed recreation site which includes a covered deck and picnic tables that overlooks the Grande Ronde Valley. Since its construction in 1990, it has been the target of many acts of vandelism involving the use of firearms. Use of firearms near this site may endanger or disturb other visitors.

ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement will be accomplished by Law Enforcement Officers only. District employees and Forest Protection Officers should report incidents of firearms use to Law Enforcement as soon as possible.

POSTING

Signs prohibiting the use of firearms will be posted at two locations, 1/4 mile either side of Indian Rock along Forest Service Road 3120. These are the only vehicle access points to the site.
