#### AREA CLOSURE

# Wallow Whitman National Forest La Grande Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50 (a) until further notice, the following acts are prohibited within areas listed below within the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest, on the La Grande Ranger District

Possessing or using a motorized vehicle off Forest development roads (36 CFR 261.56).

- SPRING CREEK SLEDDING AREA -- CLOSURE PERIOD YEAR LONG The area located in T. 3 S., R. 36 E., W.M., South 1/2 of the NW 1/4 and the North 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 4 between Forest Roads 21 and 2100680 and enclosed by wood rail fence.
- CATHERINE CREEK SUMMIT SLEDDING AREA -- CLOSURE PERIOD YEAR LONG The area located in T. 5 S., R. 41 E., W.M., SE 1/4 of Section 27 between State Hwy. 203 and Forest Road 7700950 and described as a large opening approximately 500' feet Northeast from the intersection of Hwy 203 and Forest Road 77.

The following people are exempt from this order (36 CFR 261.50(e)):

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
- Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of emergency official duties.


Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. Title 16 USC Section 551.


#### JUSTIFICATION
