### Do Not Collect Botanical Species

The following are rare vascular plants on the Willamette National Forest. We ask that you do not collect any of these species Proposed for Listing under the Endangered Species Act or Regional Forester’s Sensitive species. If you do find or collect them by accident, please contact the Forest Botanist ([Thomas.McGinnis@usda.gov](mailto:Thomas.McGinnis@usda.gov)) and let her know where you found the species so we can document and protect the site.
