## **Firewood Permit Application**

A firewood permit and load tags are required to cut and remove firewood from National Forest lands. Mt. Hood National Forest allows harvest of up to a maximum of 6 cords per household each year. This permit is being provided free of charge for personal use only. If you intend to sell or trade firewood harvested on Mt. Hood National Forest, please inquire about a commercial permit. Free Use Firewood permits expire when the season ends on November 30.

- <u>New customers</u>: Include a copy of your government-issued ID and mail to an address below.

Your permit, load tags, cutting area maps, and other information will be mailed to you within **two weeks** of receipt. Be sure to carefully read all the conditions stated on your permit before you begin cutting. For answers to questions and up-to-date information on the Firewood Program or the availability of firewood, please call the Ranger District (RD) office where you plan to cut your firewood.
