

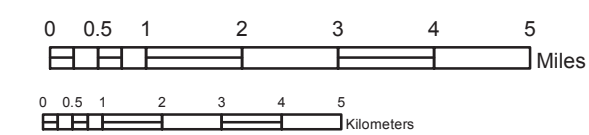

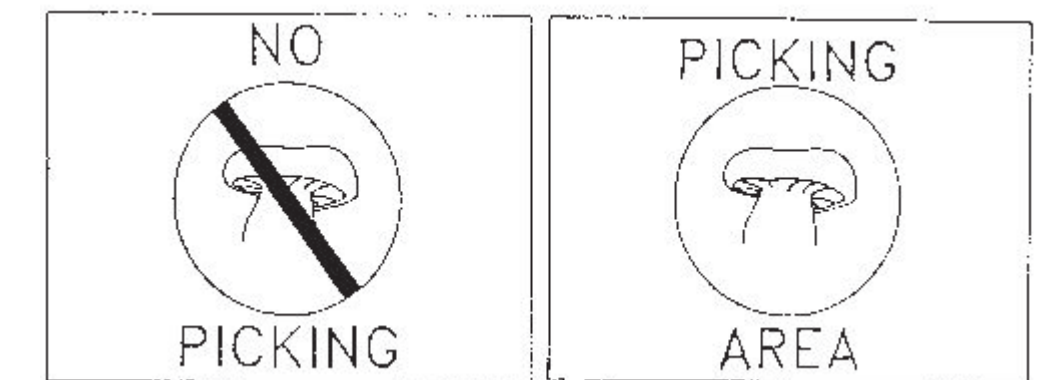
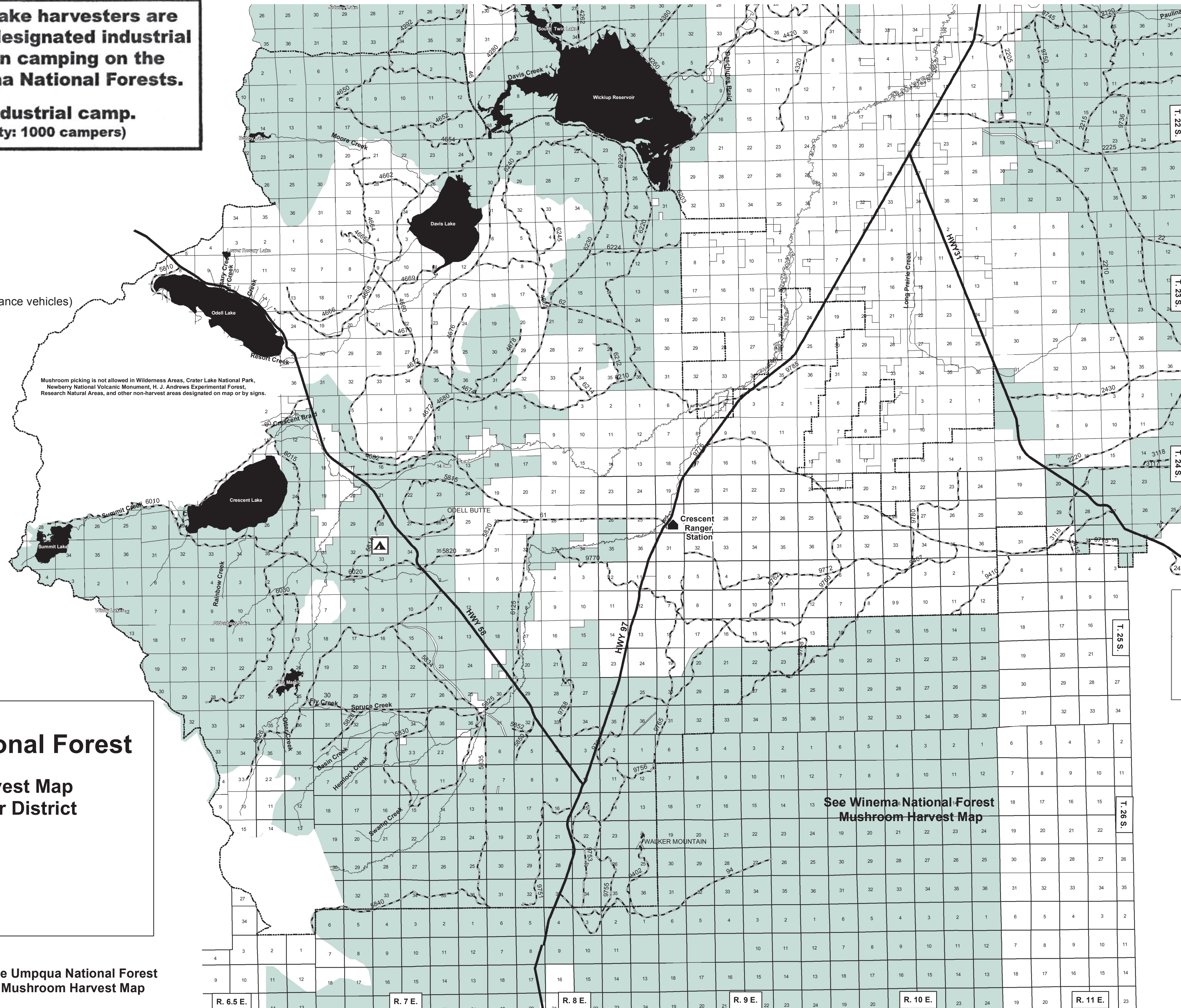

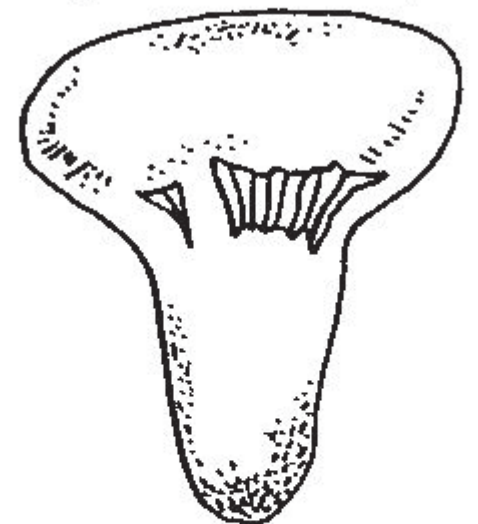


See Umpqua National Forest

DO NOT pick Matsutake with a cap diameter less than 1.5 inches and not greater than 7 inches.
