#### How to Use This Form

The following form is not a valid permit! This form is for permit application only. Use the form by filling in the boxes below and returning the completed form via email to <a href="MR.S.arpforprod@usda.gov">SM.FS.arpforprod@usda.gov</a>. Once our office receives your form, you will be contacted via phone by Forest Service staff to process a credit card payment for the official permit. Once payment is received, a permit will be emailed to you with a Forest Service staff signature. The permit must then be printed, signed by the permit holder, and carried – filling out the "Product Quantity Removal Record" section of the permit as you cut; should a law enforcement officer need to check your permit and load.

#### **Please Note**

Forest Product permit regulations and application differ from forest to forest. Below highlights important difference to take note of:

This Form – Use the form below to apply for a Forest Product permit, by sending the completed form to SM.FS.arpforprod@usda.gov.

**Signatures –** The permit holder will be responsible for printing and signing your final Forest Product permit, which will be emailed to you once payment is received.

Load Tags – The permit holder will be responsible for carrying the printed, signed copy of their permit, and filling out the "Product Quantity Removal Record" as they cut. This will be taking the place of "Load Tags" should a Law Enforcement Officer need to check the load.

Closure Areas – Several locations throughout the forest remain closed to all users because they are within burned areas. It is the permit holder's responsibility to observe closure area boundaries. # POST & POLE PERMIT

This permit is valid for the cutting and collection of up to 20 live/dead post & poles per issued unit (CCF) on public system lands only on the Sulphur Ranger District of the Arapaho and Roosevelt National Forests. PERMIT HOLDERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR IDENTIFYING THEIR LOCATION WHEN THEY ARE CUTTING AND COLLECTING MATERIAL. Signs may or may not be posted. This permit allows the cutting and gathering for the following conditions: 1) Only Live/Dead Lodgepole Pine and All Other Standing Dead trees and/or 2) Dead and down trees. ALL motorized vehicles must stay on system roads and are NOT allowed off roads to assist in collection; however, wood may be transported using carts or wheelbarrows to transport material from the Forest to your vehicle. WOOD PRODUCTS OBTAINED UNDER THIS PERMIT IS FOR PERSONAL USE AND MAY NOT BE RE-SOLD TO OTHERS.

# RULES FOR CUTTING & REMOVING WOOD

The following rules must be read and agreed to before a permit will be issued:

- A valid permit in your possession is required before cutting or transporting material. Permits are valid as indicated from the date of purchase.
- A valid permit package consists of this document and a copy of the signed permit (FS2400-1).
- Respect private property. USFS is not responsible for cutting on private land.
- Closure orders may change throughout the year and may not be displayed on the permit map.
   Permit holder is responsible for observing all official road and area closures.
- Vehicles will be parked so as not to obstruct or be a hazard to other vehicles.
- Do NOT fell trees onto any road. All trees shall be felled away from roads, and not onto road surfaces or within road ditches.
- All roads shall be kept free of any logs, stems, or branches to allow for other vehicle traffic.
- No tree felling within 125 feet of power lines.
- Do not cut any trees marked with paint.
- Do not cut bearing trees, trees that identify private property, or trees near land survey monuments (i.e.; brass cap locations).

- There will be no access behind closed/locked gates when roads are closed to the public.
- Material may NOT be cut or gathered in wilderness areas or within 500 feet of developed recreation sites including campgrounds, picnic areas, summer home groups, or trailheads.
- Do NOT cut or gather wood from log decks or hand or machine piles.
- Material cut and/or collected under this permit shall be no greater than 7 inches in diameter and cut into lengths of 16 feet or less, prior to removal from National Forest System Lands.
- Cut stumps to a 6 inch height or less.
- All branches and other slash will be scattered so that it lies within 12" of the ground.
- Remove all slash from roadway surfaces, ditches, culverts, trails, and stream channels by scattering back into the forest.
- Pack out all litter.
- Failure to comply with regulations may cause permit revocation and/or a fine.
- Extensions or refunds will not be granted.
