FOREST ORDER

Pursuant to 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B, it is hereby ordered that the following prohibitions hereinafter set forth apply to the Indian Boundary Recreation Area, Swimming Area, Tellico Ranger District, within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached maps. The swimming area is designated by buoy lines on the lake as shown on Map 2. This order is effective upon signing for 2 years unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.

- 1. Leaving or storing boats, including kayaks and canoes, in the swimming area. 36 CFR 261.58(p)
- 2. Launching boats, including kayaks and canoes, except at a designated launching ramp. 36 CFR 261.58(r)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from the above prohibitions:

- 1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of their official duty.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


