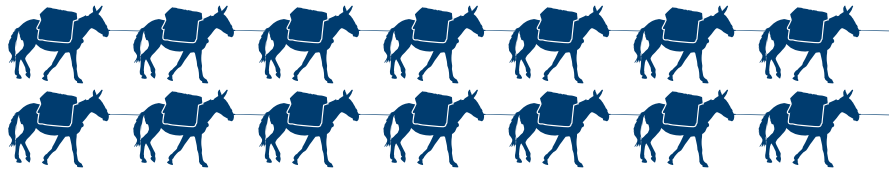

## Ecosystem Management

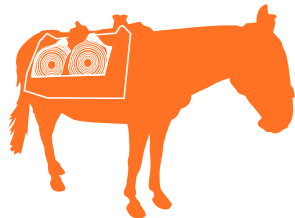

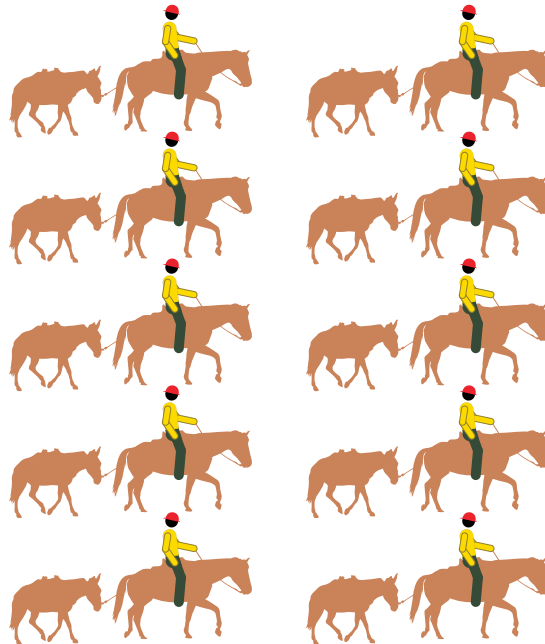

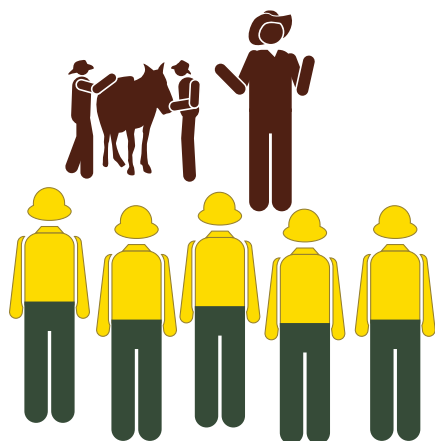
In total, packers spent 356 person/days assigned to wildfires

**Did You Know?** It is estimated that this saved \$1.2 million over the use of helicopters and allowed limited helicopter resources to focus on higher priority time-sensitive missions.

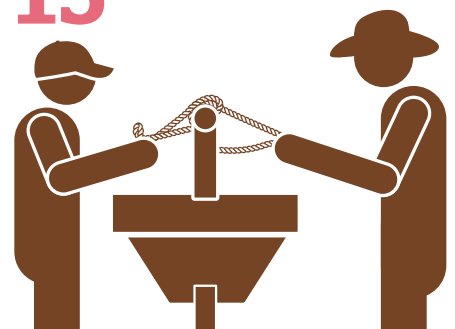


**Did You Know?** In a typical year packers present about 250 hours of training, reaching over 1,100 people: this includes 560 agency personnel and approximately 650 partners, volunteers, and members of the public.

**Did You Know?** Since 2013 the Pack Stock Center of Excellence has trained 15 apprentices, nine of them now work for land management agencies, many in pack stock related jobs.
