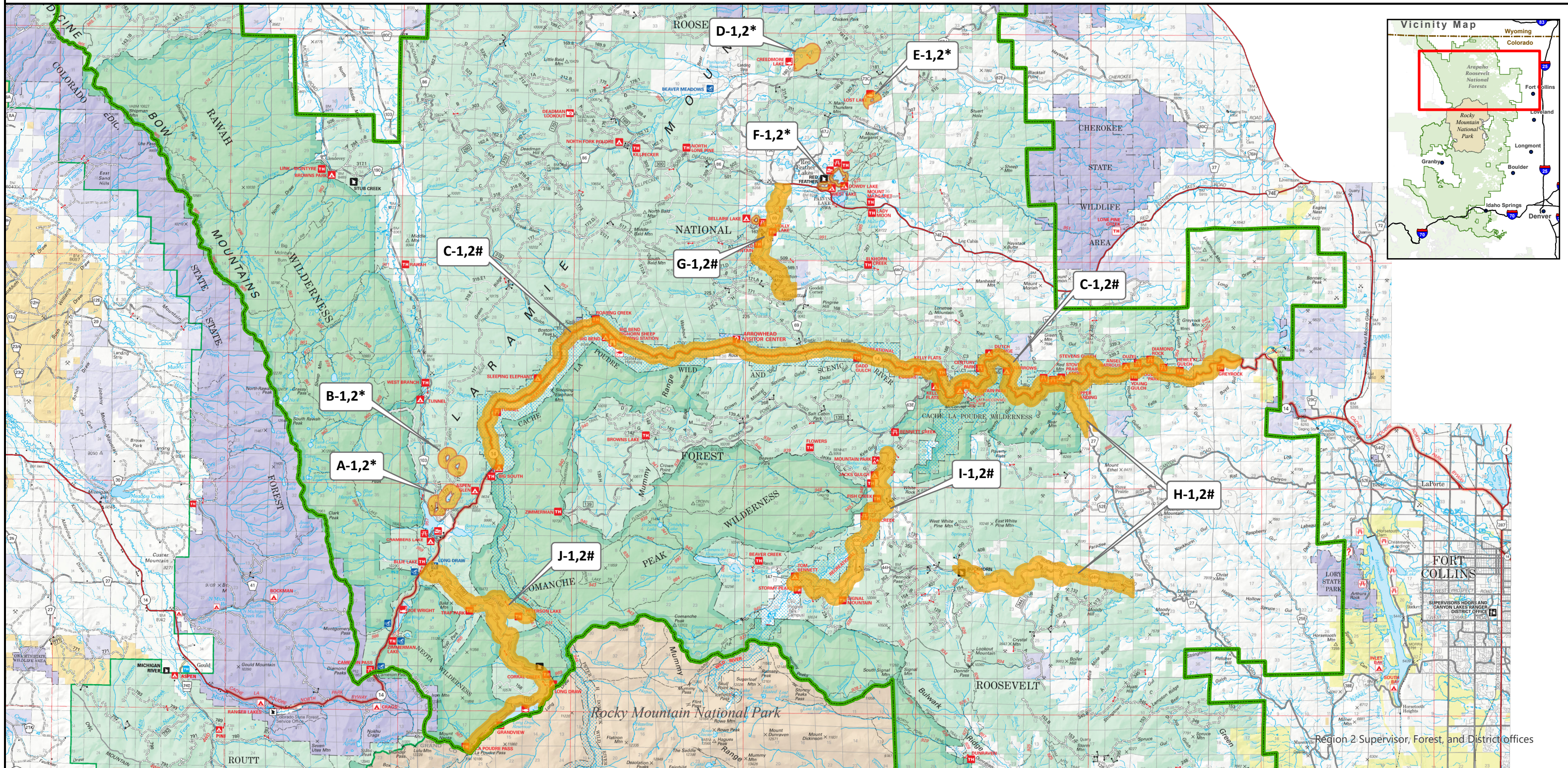

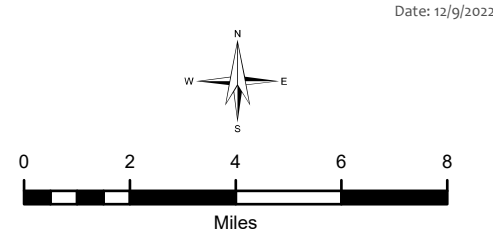

C	Poudre Canyon	All NFS lands within ¼ mile of the portion of Colorado Highway 14 beginning at the National Forest boundary between MM 117 and MM 118 west and ending at the Big South Trailhead	1, 2 and #
D	Creedmore Lakes	All NFS lands within 100 feet of Creedmore Lakes, which are located in Section 4, Township 10 North, Range 73 West, 6th P.M.	1, 2, and *
E	Lost Lake	All NFS lands within 100 feet of Lost Lake, which is located in Section 12, Township 10 North, Range 73 West, 6th P.M.	1, 2, and *
F	Dowdy Lake, West Lake and Bellaire Lake	All NFS lands within 100 feet of Dowdy, West, and Bellaire Lakes, which are located in Sections 26 and 27, Township 10 North, Range 73 West, and Section 6, Township 9 North, Range 73 West, 6th P.M.	1, 2, and *
G	Manhattan Road (CR 69)	All NFS lands within ¼ mile of the portion of Larimer County Road 69 beginning at its junction with Larimer County Road 74 E to the south and ending after approximately 6 miles at the point the road enters private land	1, 2, and #
H	Stove Prairie Road (CR 27) And Buckhorn Canyon Road (CR 44H)	All NFS lands within ¼ mile of Larimer County Road 27 beginning at its junction with Colorado Highway 14 and ending at the National Forest boundary; and within ¼ mile of Larimer County Road 44H beginning at its junction with the National Forest boundary and ending at its junction with NFS Road (NFSR) 100	1, 2, and #
I	Pingree Park Road	All NFS lands within ¼ mile of Larimer County Road 63E beginning at its junction with Camman Spring Road (NFSR 127) and ending at the National Forest boundary at Pingree Park	1, 2, and #
J	Longdraw Road and Peterson Lake Road	All NFS lands within ¼ mile of Longdraw Road (NFSR 156) from Colorado Highway 14 to the gate at the boundary with RMNP; and Peterson Lake Road (NFSR 159) from its junction with Longdraw Road to its end	1, 2, and #
