**Notice of Intent
General Information**

The Notice of Intent must be submitted to the District Ranger and answers the basics of who, what, when, and where of an operation. A plan of operations may be submitted in lieu of a Notice of Intent.

A notice of intent is required for the following (36 CFR 228):

- Anything that will cause disturbance to ground. (Not required for hand panning).
- Any motorized or mechanized operations.
- Access or use other than what is allowed by the public.

The District Ranger will reply within 15 days after the Notice of Intent is received at the office or by email. If the District Ranger approves the Notice of Intent, the operator may begin operations. If District Ranger determines significant disturbance is likely, the operator will have to prepare a plan of operations which includes provisions for the protection and rehabilitation of surface resources.
