Weather – Berlin, NH	Thursday night: A 20 percent chance of showers and thunderstorms before 11pm. Patchy fog after 2am. Otherwise, partly cloudy, with a low around 64. South wind around 5 mph becoming calm in the evening.
	Friday: A slight chance of showers, then a chance of showers and thunderstorms after noon. Some of the storms could produce small hail, gusty winds, and heavy rain. Areas of fog before 9am. Otherwise, mostly sunny, with a high near 86. Calm wind becoming south around 5 mph in the afternoon. Chance of precipitation is 40%. New rainfall amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms.
	Friday night: A 50 percent chance of showers and thunderstorms. Some of the storms could produce heavy rain. Patchy fog after 11pm. Otherwise, mostly cloudy, with a low around 64. South wind around 5 mph becoming calm in the evening.
	Saturday: A chance of showers and thunderstorms before 9am, then a chance of showers between 9am and 3pm, then showers likely and possibly a thunderstorm after 3pm. Patchy fog before 10am. Otherwise, mostly cloudy, with a high near 82. Calm wind becoming southeast around 5 mph. Chance of precipitation is 70%.
