ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR SPECIAL AREA RESTRICTIONS<br>FOR THE OLD LAKEWOOD LANDFILL CHEQUAMEGON-NICOLET NATIONAL FOREST

Under authority of the Act of Congress of June 4, 1897, 16 USC 551, and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations set forth at 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following acts or omissions are prohibited on National Forest System lands on the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest in Oconto County, Wisconsin (See description of Affected Area and Vicinity Map, Exhibit A):

1. It is prohibited to go into or be upon the area on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday of each week. 36 CFR 261.53(f).
2. It is prohibited to be in the area after sundown or before sunrise. 36 CFR 261.58(I).

AFFECTED AREA: That portion of the Lakewood/Laona Ranger District, ChequamegonNicolet National Forest, located at Township 33 North, Range 16 East, North $1 / 2$ of the Northwest $1 / 4$ Section 29; west of Forest Road 2341 (the North Road), in the vicinity of Lakewood, Oconto County, Wisconsin (see Vicinity Map, Exhibit A).

THESE RESTRICTIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS FOUND AT 36 CFR PART 261. SUBPART A, AND FOREST SUPERVISOR'S ORDER NO. R913-06-0 1 FOR OCCUPANCY \& USE OF THE CHEQUAMEGON-NICOLET NATIONAL FOREST, AND WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF THIS ORDER UNTIL TERMINATED OR RESCINDED BY THE FOREST SUPERVISOR.

Pursuant to 36 CPR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
