Toboggan Trail (T5003) Closure

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b) the following is prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) trails in the Sacramento Ranger District, Lincoln National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

1. Being on the trail. **36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a)**.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

DESCRIBED TRAIL

As shown in Exhibit A, the following trail is closed:

The entirety of Trail No. 5003.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety and to allow the Forest

Service to complete necessary trail repairs. This trail will be repaired and maintained as resources are identified, prioritized, and become available to complete the work needed to protect public health and safety.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order shall be in effect from February 02, 2024, at 6:00 a.m. through February 02, 2027, at 8:00 a.m., unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the Described closed trail is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/lincoln/alerts-notice>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

6. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same or similar acts in the same Described Trail.

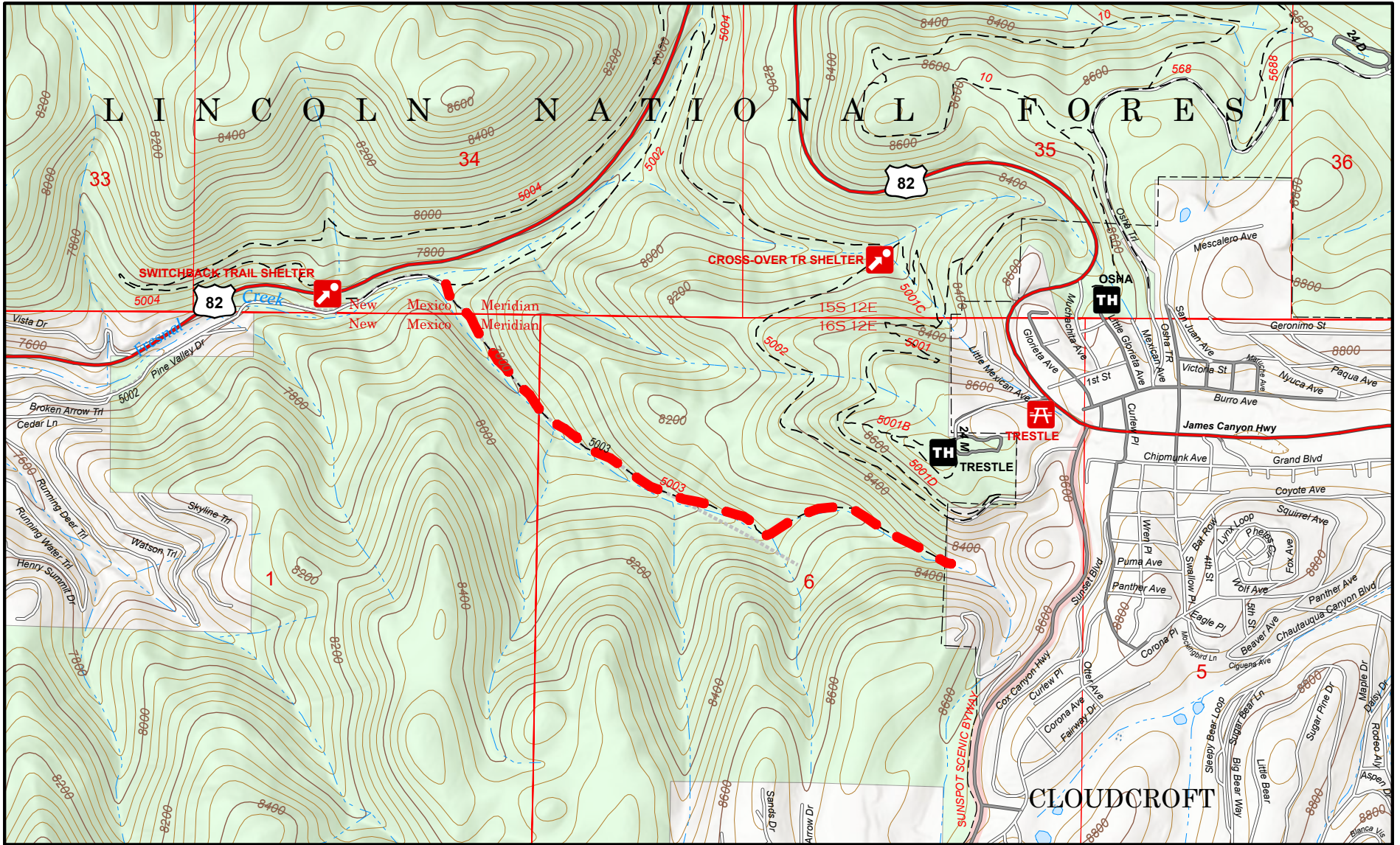

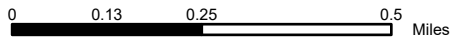
