



Directions: From Flagstaff, travel south on Lake Mary Road. Make a right turn onto Forest Road 132. Drive for about 3 miles, there will a pile of wood on the left side of the road before the gate.

The permitted free use area is for wood logs from a county hazard tree removal. The piles contain logs over 12ft. Removing logs from slash piles is authorized but any slash resulting from your activities must be put back on piles. Only dead and down logs are available to take in the free use area. This permit does not authorize motorized cross-country travel to scout for wood, however you may use your vehicle off road to gather wood.
