Taylor Creek Road Closure III

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b) the following are prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) road in the Tally Lake Ranger District, Flathead National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "Described Road"):

1. Prohibition: Being on the road 36 C.F.R. 261.54(e).

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
- 2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.

DESCRIBED ROAD

Road # 9790 (MP 0.00) – Closed for the entire length to public use starting at the junction with Upper Whitefish Road, Section 6, T32N, R22W; PMM; Flathead County (see attached map, Exhibit A).

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is for public safety during logging activities associated with the GNA Taylor Hellroaring Timber Sale.

IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. This Order shall be in effect from July 1, 2024, at 0800 hours through September 30th, 2024 at 2000 hours, unless rescinded.
- 2. A map identifying the Described Road is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <u>https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/flathead/alerts-notices</u>.
- 3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
- 4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

- 6. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same or similar acts on the same Described Road.
