OCCUPANCY AND USE

PURSUANT TO PROVISIONS OF 16 U.S.C., SECTION 551 AND 36 CFR 261.50 (a) AND (b), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT THE FOLLOWING ACTS ARE PROHIBITED ON THE AREA DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDER AS, **FRIENDSHIP TRAIL AREA** WITHIN THE DESIGNATED AREA INDICATED BY PAINTED BOUNDARIES (SEE ATTACHED MAP) WITHIN THE OUACHITA NATIONAL FOREST.

THE FOLLOWING PROHIBITED ACTS ARE SET FORTH IN 36 CFR 261.58:

- 261.58(e) Camping.
- 261.58(k) Entering or being in a body of water.
- 261.58(I) Being on the trail after sundown or before sunrise.
- 261.58(m) Discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun in the designated area.
- 261.58(v) Hunting in the designated area.

PURSUANT TO 36 CFR, SECTION 261.50 (e), THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS ORDER:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions 36 CFR part 261, Subpart A.

THIS ORDER WILL EXPIRE TWO (2) YEARS FROM DATE OF EXECUTION
