Lake Fork Closure

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 both (a) and (b) the following are prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) lands and roads in the Price Ranger District, Manti-La Sal National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A "Described Area and Road"

- 1. Using any type of motor vehicle or trailer on the Described Road except for day use by high clearance vehicles (without attached trailers), 36 CFR § 261.54 (a)
- 2. Camping in the Described Area, 36 CFR § 261.58(e)

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
- 2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.
- 3. Persons or high clearance vehicles (without attached trailers) in the area or on the road between 6 am and 10 pm.

DESCRIBED AREA AND ROAD

The Described Area is all NFS lands 300 feet on either side of NFS Road # 50070 (Lake Fork Canyon Road), beginning from the NFS Boundary in Lake Fork Canyon and continuing to the road's intersection with NFS Road # 50006 (Dairy Fork Road), including all dispersed campsites within 300 feet of the roadway.

The Described Road is NFS Road # 50070 (Lake Fork Canyon Road), beginning at the NFS Boundary in Lake Fork Canyon and continuing to the road's intersection with NFS Road # 50006 (Dairy Fork Road).

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect public safety.

IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. This Order shall be in effect from June 7, 2024 at 0800 through December 31, 2024 at 2000, unless rescinded.
- 2. A map identifying the Described Area and Road is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/mantilasal/alerts-notices.
- 3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
- 4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

- 6. This Order supersedes Order 04-10-3-24-02 prohibiting the same or similar acts in/on the same Described Area/Road.
