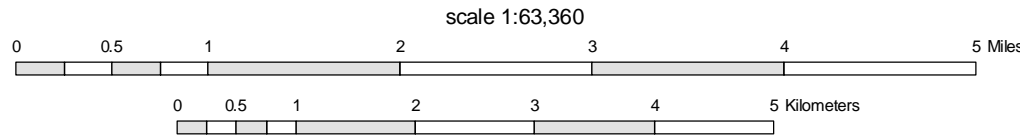


# Oconee National Forest - South Half
