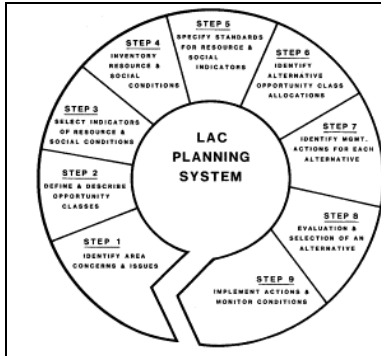


# Limits of Acceptable Change Process

	<b>RESOURCE INDICATOR</b>
1	Proximity of protected resource to a system trail or user trail
2	Damage to vegetation/trees
3	Scouring of vegetation on rock cliffs
4	Illegal 4-wheeler use
