MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST FOREST ORDER NO. 08-24-10 USDA FOREST SERVICE CEDAR CAMP CAMPGROUND CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Mendocino National Forest. This Order is effective from June 17, 2024, through June 18, 2026.

1. Entering or using the developed recreation site Cedar Camp Campground, as shown Exhibit A. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58(b).

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation of Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire-fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571 and 3581.
