Parking Restrictions

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Mt. Hough Ranger District of the Plumas National Forest. This Order shall be in effect from June 25, 2024, through July 15, 2024.

Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions on Forest Road No. 28N15, including along the Road's shoulder, as shown on the attached map. **36 CFR 261.58(g).**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire-fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

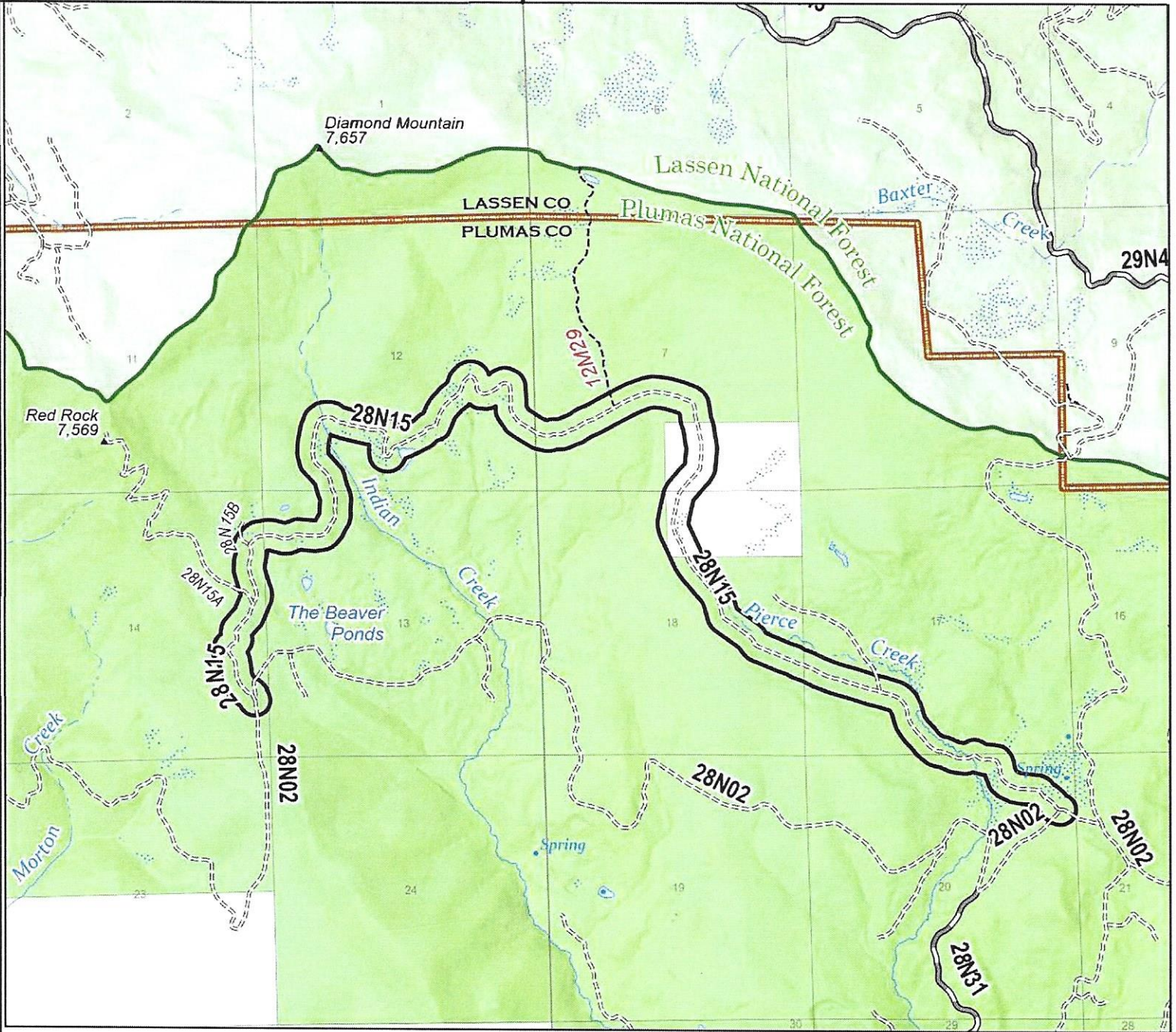


Mount Hough District

Plumas National Forest, Mount Hough Ranger District

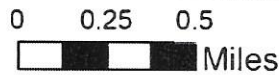

 Parking Restriction Area

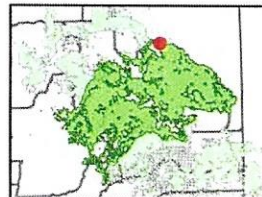
