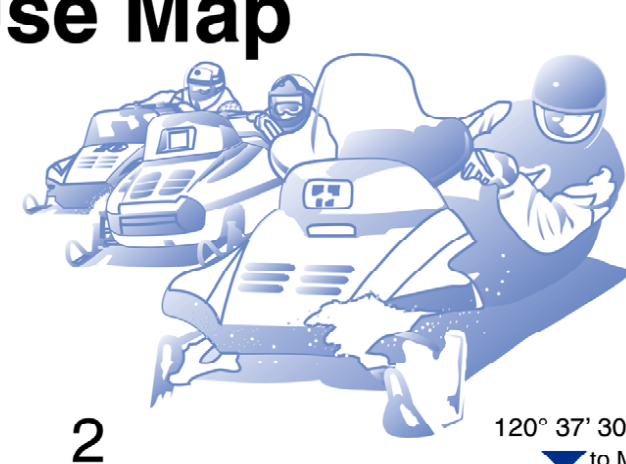
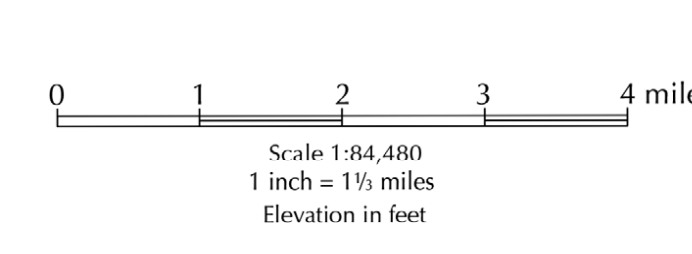


USDA **Over-Snow Vehicle Use Map**

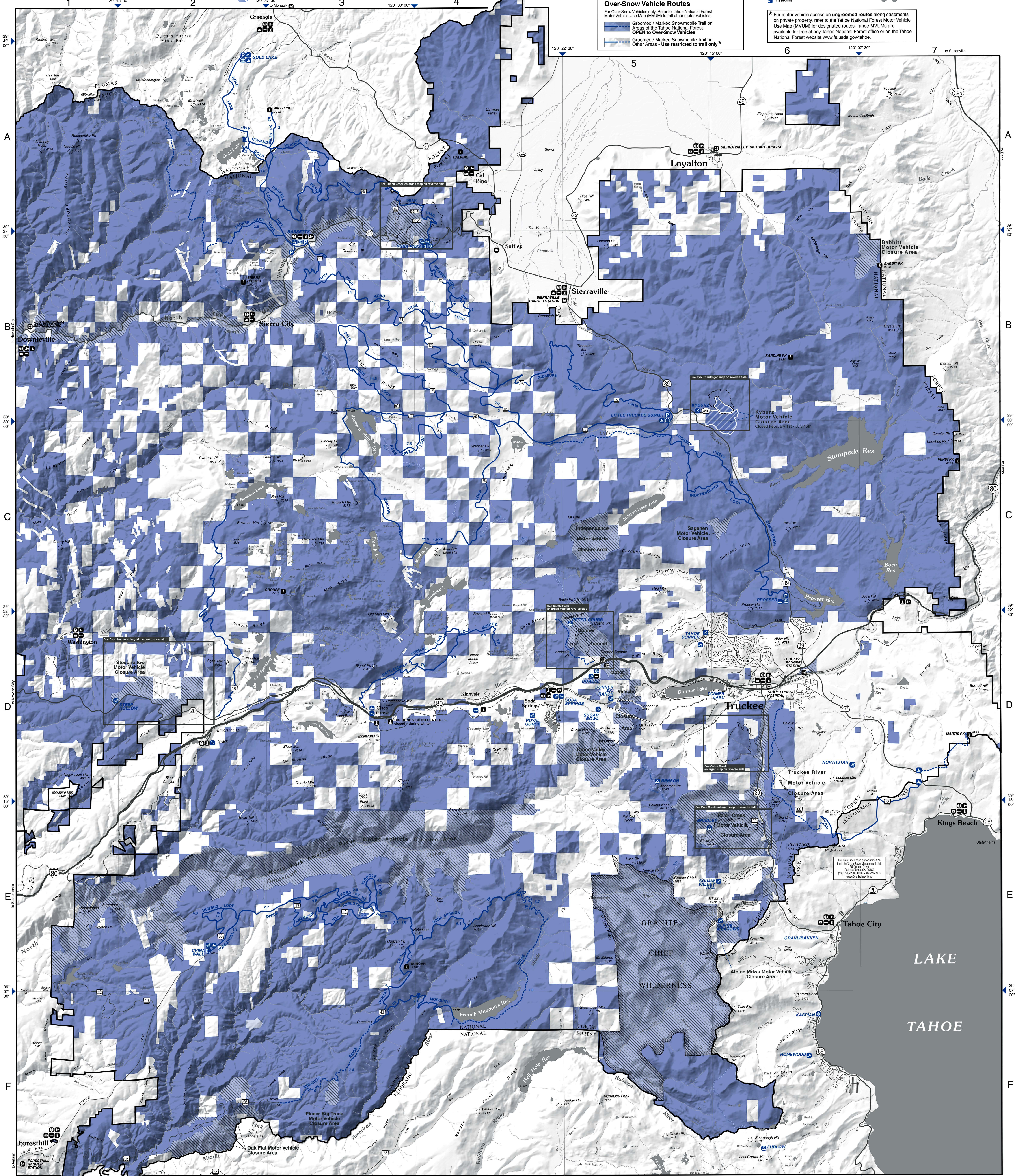
