

ORDER NO. 08-04-01/03-401

UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

CHEROKEE NATIONAL FOREST

Recreation Restriction

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a), it is hereby ordered that the prohibitions hereinafter set forth apply to the Kings Slough Boat Ramp, Ocoee/Hiwassee District, within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map.

1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire. **36 CFR 261.52(a)**
2. Camping. **36 CFR 261.58(e)**
3. Entering or being in a body of water (swimming). **36 CFR 261.58(k)**
4. Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by State Law. **36 CFR 261.58(bb)**
5. Hunting. **36 CFR 261.58(v)**


The above-prohibited act is set forth in Title 36 C.F.R. Section CFR 261.58 and 261.52.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons or areas are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.

Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
