2016 Chinook Redds along the Middle Fork Salmon River

September 23, 2016


Multiple redds have been located this year. One camp is closed, Lost Oak, for redd protection. This redd is just off the left bank, near the normal channel. If possible, take the right run; if not, hug tight to the left. Our river patrol floated down the right side recently with somewhat heavy rafts. There were salmon working on the redd at that time.

Identified chinook salmon redds will have red flagging approx. 100 feet upstream of the redd on the river bank closest to the redd and green flagging approx. 100 feet downstream to let boaters know they are past the redd. Boaters are asked to move away, as far as safely possible, from the flagged side of the river once they see the red flagging. When floating through the flagged section, please float quietly, use minimal oaring and avoid standing up in your boats, as this can scare



the fish off the redd. Adult salmon need all of their energy to build their nest and spawn.


When you float past the green flagging, you can resume normal boating operations.
