Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the Wayehutta ORV Parking Area, Jackson County, Nantahala National Forest. This order is in effect from January 27, 2016 until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

- 1. Camping or establishing a campsite within 500 feet of the Wayehutta ORV Parking Area. 36 CFR 261.58 (e)
- 2. Building and or maintaining a campfire. 36 CFR 261. 52 (a)
- 3. Possession of an alcoholic beverage as defined byu state law. 36 CFR 261.58 (bb)
- 4. Being in the area ½ after sunset and ½ before sunrise. 36 CFR 261.58 (1)

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons or areas are exempt from this Order:

- Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.


