Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the Balsam Lake Day Use Area, Jackson County. Nantahala National Forest. This order is in effect from January 27, 2016 until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

- Camping within and around the Balsam Lake Day Use Area, the Tom nMalonee Fishing Trail and Wolf Creek Fishing Trail. 36 CFR 261.58(e)
- 2. Building and or maintaining a fire or campfire. 36 CFR 261.52(a)
- 3. Being in the area 1/2 hour after sunset or 1/2 hour before sunrise. 36 CFR 261.58(1)
- 4. Possessing or operating a motorboat or watercraft with an engine other than a battery operated or electric powered. 36 CFR 261.58(n)

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons or areas are exempt from this Order:

- Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.


