HORNSILVER CAMPGROUND

Access from Vail:

- Travel west on I-70 to Exit 171 for Minturn, Leadville, and Hwy 24.
- Turn right and travel south about 12 miles.
- The campground is on the left.

Facilities:

- There are 7 campsites each with a campfire grate and table.
- Parking spurs at campsites are 30 feet long.
- Drinking water is not available.
- Vault toilet with no wash sinks available.

Attractions:

- The campground is located across Hwy 24 from the Homestake Creek in a forested setting.
- There are several trailheads off Homestake Road-FSR 703, which is about 1 mile south of the campground on Hwy.24.
- Fishing is fair to good in Homestake Creek. Homestake Road follows the creek all the way to Homestake Reservoir where the fishing is fair. Backcountry lakes offer the more hardy fishers some good exercise as well as excellent dishing opportunities in Whitney Lake, Fancy Lake, Cleveland Lake, and the Missouri Lakes.
- Homestake Reservoir is 10 miles up Homestake Road. It is a 480 acre reservoir and offers opportunities for canoeing, kayaking and use of small rowboats.
