## HUNTING OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the **Natural Bridge**, **Brushy Lake**, **and Sipsey River Picnic Area**, **Developed Recreation Sites**, on the **Bankhead Ranger District**, of the National Forests in Alabama, Winston County, Alabama. This closure order is effective **until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor**.

The following act is **PROHIBITED** as set forth in 36 CFR 261.58:

Hunting within a designated recreation area. 36 CFR 261.58 (v)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following person(s) are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
