PROTECTION OF SPECIES-GOPHER TORTOISE OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and 36 CFR 261.53 (a), in the interest of the protection of wildlife, the following prohibitions applies to the Conecuh Ranger District of the National Forests in Alabama. This closure order is effective until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

The following is **PROHIBITED** as set forth in **36 CFR 261.58**:

- 1. Hunting, possessing, storing, or transporting of Gopher Tortoise. 36 CFR 261.58 (s)
- 2. Hunting of any wildlife species by the practice of "gassing" burrows. 36 CFR 261.58 (v)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in performance of any official duty.
