OCCUPANCY AND USE MT. BAKER-SNOQUALMIE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited within the Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest, until further notice.

1. Camping or residing on any individual Ranger District in excess of 14 days during any 30 day period. 36 CFR 261.58(a)

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This order supercedes order number 06-05-20-93-004
