Whether it is winter, spring, summer or fall, you can experience all of the seasons in a Forest Service rental cabin and live the life of a ranger. The Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest has 25 rental cabins spread across 3.3 million acres of land. These recreation rentals are offered to the public under the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act. Rental fees are retained locally to help maintain and preserve these historic cabins.

Be a Part of History!

Cabins on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge Forest are historic representations of once-operating, fully staffed remote ranger stations, guard stations and mining camps. Guard stations were intermediate protective facilities between the ranger station and the back country. They were strategically located to afford maximum contact with the public headed into the back country. Rangers that stayed in these cabins performed tasks such as checking permits, providing information and educating those passing by about the dangers involved with fire.
