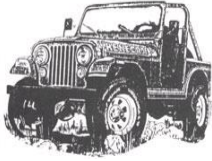


Sierra National Forest



Asks you to Not Trespass and
ASK Property Owners FIRST
To Ride on their Private Property



Use the **FREE Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) to know where you can legally ride on the designated roads and trails on the Sierra National Forest.

- All private property is white on the MVUM, contrasting the gray representing the National Forest. Any road or trail that ends at the white area, indicates that there is no easement for going through that land.
- Respect the private property and ask permission rather than trespassing.



You are responsible to check the MVUM to make sure you only travel on the designated roads & trails. The MVUMs show limited information:

- The open roads, trails, and areas
- Some geographic locations

**The Forest recommends use of the Forest Visitor Map (\$15.00) in conjunction with the MVUM for more Forest details and assistance with orientation on the forest.
