## ORDER NO. 05-07-51-17-04 ROADSIDE CAMPING PROHIBITION LOS PADRES NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited in the Monterey Ranger District within the Los Padres National Forest. This Order is effective from August 11, 2017, through August 10, 2018.

1. Camping is prohibited along Nacimiento-Fergusson Road, as specifically described in Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.58(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for and individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
