

**ORDER NO. 0507-51-18-05**

**LOS PADRES NATIONAL FOREST**

**NACIMIENTO-FERGUSON ROAD  
ROADSIDE CAMPING PROHIBITION**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited in the Monterey Ranger District within the Los Padres National Forest. This Order is effective from August 10, 2018 through August 9, 2019.

Camping within 300 feet of the center line of Forest Road No. 22S01 (Nacimiento-Fergusson Road), starting at its intersection with State Highway 1 in Section 25, Township 22 South, Range 4 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continuing east to mile post 10.3 in Section 15, Township 22 South, Range 5 East, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.58(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
