

# Forest Development Roads and Trails

Attachment No. 96-06-28

The following is an attachment to Regional Order R-10-96-01, and is in effect until rescinded. These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibition in 36 CFR, Part 261.


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b) and Regional Order R-10-96-01, Forest Development Roads and Trails, the following are prohibited unless a permit has been issued:

- 36 CFR 261.54(a): **Juneau Creek Road (#972) is closed from mile 0.08 to the terminus to all vehicle traffic. This includes all highway and off-highway vehicles, whether motorized or non-motorized. This closure is due to safety concerns with logging traffic on a narrow road with few wide sections.**
- 36.CFR 261.54(a): **Crossing or being on the Palmer Creek bridge at mile 11.5 of Palmer Creek Road (#901) with any motorized vehicle is prohibited.**
- 36 CFR 261.54(a): **Palmer Creek Road (#901) is closed to all motorized vehicles from April 1<sup>st</sup> through June 15<sup>th</sup>, to protect the road surface from damage.**
- 36 CFR 261.55(b): **Resurrection Pass Trail (#317), and Devil's Pass Trail (#305) are closed to all motorized vehicles from February 16<sup>th</sup> through November 30<sup>th</sup>.**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty,
- (2) Any Forest Service contractors or permittees in the performance of their contract or permit.
