Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a) and (b), it is hereby ordered that the prohibitions hereinafter set forth apply to the Paint Creek Road, Forest System Road #41, Nolichucky/Unaka District, within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map. This closure order is effective until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

- 1. Use of a vehicle with a horse trailer. 36 CFR 261.54a
- Riding, hitching, tethering or hobbling a horse or other saddle or pack animal in violation of posted instructions within the designated area on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays from May 15 through September 15 for each calendar year.
 36 CFR 261.58aa

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons or areas are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
