Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a), it is hereby ordered that the prohibitions hereinafter set forth apply to specific areas described below on the Tellico Ranger District, within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map. This closure order is effective until rescinded or superseded by another signed by the Forest Supervisor.

1. Closed to Forest visitors for protection of the objects or areas of historical, archeological, geological, or paleontological interest. (36 CFR 261.53c).

The above-prohibited act is set forth in Title 36 C.F.R. Sections 261.53.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt or areas are exempt from this Order:

- Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
