USDA - FOREST SERVICE

WILDERNESS


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a), the following act is prohibited in the Glacier View, Indian Heaven, Mt. Adams, Tatoosh, and Trapper Creek Wildernesses on the Gifford Pinchot National Forest, and the Goat Rocks, and William O. Douglas Wildernesses on the Gifford Pinchot and Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie (administered by the Wenatchee National Forest) National Forests.

1. Entering or being in the area. 36 CFR 261.57(a)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this order:


1. Persons with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
