**ENTRY AND USE RESTRICTIONS**

**GIFFORD PINCHOT NATIONAL FOREST, WENATCHEE NATIONAL FOREST,  
MT. BAKER-SNOQUALMIE NATIONAL FOREST, AND OKANOGAN NATIONAL FOREST**

In order to protect Forest and Wilderness resources, the following acts pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), are prohibited within the Gifford Pinchot, Wenatchee, Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie, and Okanogan National Forests, until further notice:

- (1) Shortcutting a **trail** switchback, 36 CFR 261.55(e).
- (2) Being in an area posted as being **closed for restoration, wilderness restoration, or rehabilitation**. 36 CFR 261.53(b).

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from clause one of this Order:

- (1) None.

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from clause two of this Order:

- (1) Any Forest Officer or member of an organized rehabilitation crew engaged in a rehabilitation project.

**DEFINITIONS:**

Trail -

This definition includes all system trails identified in the trail inventory of the respective National Forests.

Closed for restoration, wilderness restoration, or rehabilitation -

This includes any area posted by the Forest Service as a RESTORATION SITE, WILDERNESS RESTORATION SITE, WILDERNESS REVEGETATION SITE, or REHABILITATION SITE. Signing will consist, at a minimum, of two conspicuously placed 4x6 inch signs with the words RESTORATION, REVEGETATION, or REHABILITATION printed on it.
