SPECIAL CLOSURE

USDA - FOREST SERVICE

GIFFORD PINCHOT NATIONAL FOREST


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following act is prohibited within the Tatoosh Lakes Basin within the GIFFORD PINCHOT NATIONAL FOREST, until rescinded

1. Camping 36 CFR 261.58(e)
2. Possessing or using a saddle, pack, or draft animal. 36 CFR 261.55(c)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or local law enforcement officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force, or Forest Officer, or Forest Service Volunteer, or Forest Service Human Resource Program Enrollee in the performance of an official duty, only to the extent necessary to perform those official duties.
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.

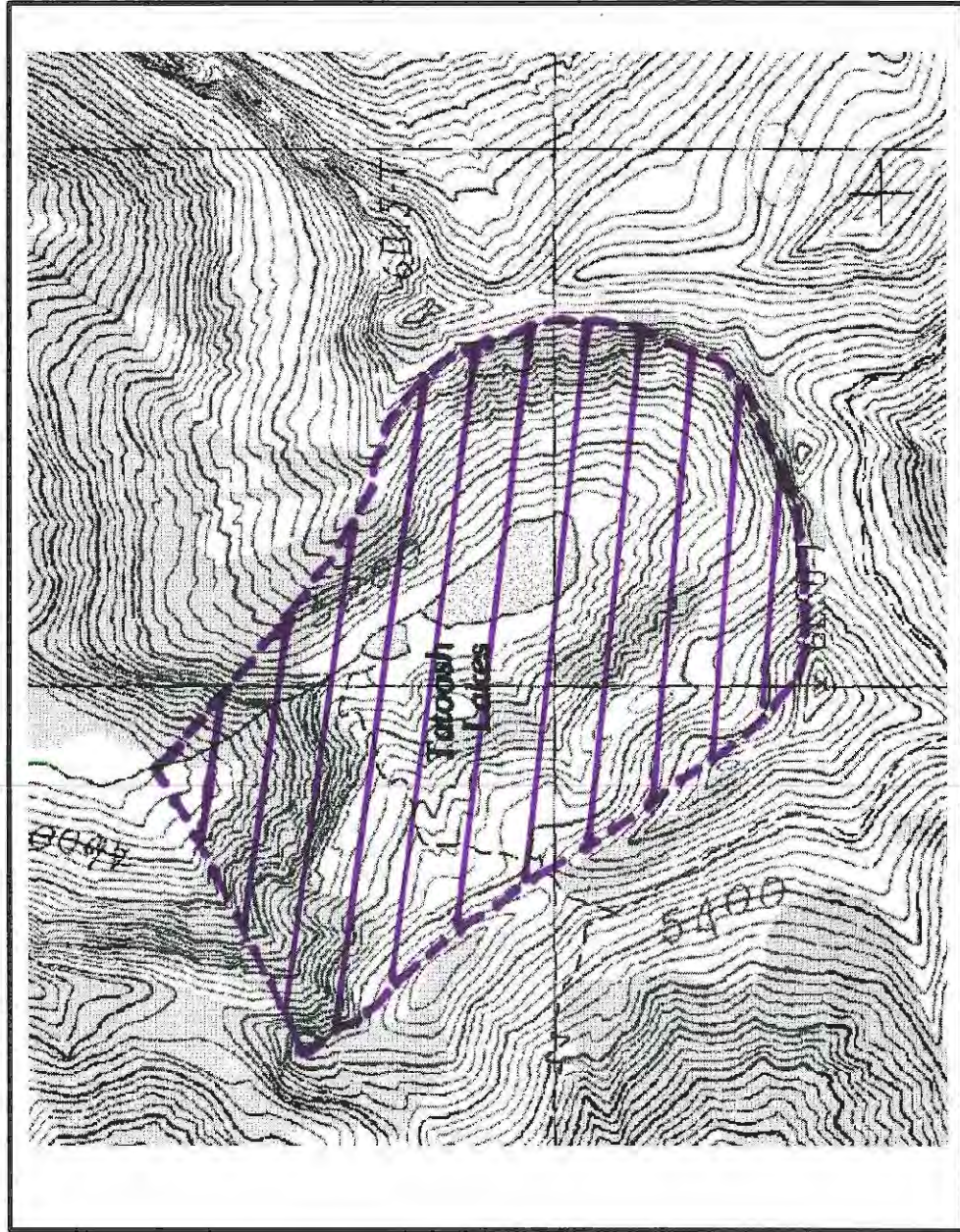
