

EMERGENCY PROHIBITIONS

FOREST SUPERVISOR ORDER NO. 08-13-04-19-01

ROAD 209, 222, 233, 234 & 271 CLOSURE

Pursuant to authorities found in 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and 36 CFR 261.53(e), and due to the severe deterioration and erosion which has occurred that has compromised the road bed and jeopardizes public health and safety, I am closing the following area:

AREA CLOSED: Portions of National Forest System Roads (NFSR): 209, 222, 233, 234 & 271

in Montgomery & Walker Counties. (See the attached map for the location.)

EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDER: This Emergency Closure Order is effective from February 25, 2019 until

rescinded.

PROHIBITED ACTS: No motorized vehicle may enter any closed portions of the roads identified on

the attached map.

<u>Definition:</u> For the purposes of this Prohibition, the definition of a Forest Service System

Road can be found in 36 CFR 261.2.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

a. Persons with permission from a forest officer;

- b. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission; and
- c. Any Federal, State, or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
